Since then, sixteen cycles of ASP studies have been activated. ASP selects 150 students per year, among the top 5% applicants to Master Degree programmes in Engineering, Architecture and Design at Politecnico di Milano and Politecnico di Torino

ASP fosters new approaches aimed at developing tailored forms of education, engaging students into personalized learning programs that include innovation projects and residential schools. ASP addresses the formalization of societal problems that are complex and ill-structured, to make students become aware of the complexity of their solutions. Through this understanding, students refine their ability to produce a positive impact on societal and environmental challenges, to become fully responsible and aware of the social effects of each of their design, technological and entrepreneurial acts.

ASP Alumni Association is the network made by students who graduated from Alta Scuola Politecnica. It now counts more than 1500 members spread around the world (primarily Italy, Europe and USA).
