In 2004, the Politecnico di Milano and the Politecnico di Torino launched the Alta Scuola Politecnica (ASP), a honours programme focused on multidisciplinary and innovation. Since then, sixteen cycles of ASP studies have been activated.

ASP is a school for young and exceptionally talented students, with a passion for innovation, who wish to develop their potential in a multidisciplinary community.

ASP fosters new approaches aimed at developing tailored education by engaging students into personalized learning programmes.

ASP selects 150 students per year, among the top 5% applicants to Master Degree programmes in Engineering, Architecture and Design at Politecnico di Milano (PoliMi) and Politecnico di Torino (PoliTo).

This year the ASP Opening (17th cycle) and Graduation Ceremony (15th cycle) is an opportunity to celebrate those who have successfully completed a demanding and intense path, and also to reflect about the unique features of the ASP programme, that combines the robustness of deep vertical education - provided by the Master Degree programmes at Politecnico di Milano and Politecnico di Torino - with the richness and openness of a horizontal interdisciplinary programme - offered by ASP.

GIAN MARIA GROS-PIETRO

Chairman of the Board of Directors of Intesa Sanpaolo since April 2016, after having been Chairman of the Bank's Management Board since May 2013. He is currently a member of the Executive Committee of ABI. At Consob, he chairs the Committee of Market Operators and Investors and is a member of the Corporate Governance Committee of Borsa Italiana. He was Chairman (non-executive and independent) of ASTM (2012-2020), Lead Independent Director of Edison Spa until April 2019, Independent Director of Fiat (2005-2014), chairing also its Audit Committee, Chairman of Atlantia (2002-2010), Chairman of ENI (1999-2002) and IRI (1997-1999), Senior Advisor for Italy of Société Générale Corporate & Investment Banking (2005-2009) and member of the European Advisory Board of Rothschild & Cie Banque (2002-2005). At Luiss University, where he is currently a member of the Board of Directors, he directed the Department of Economics and Business from 2004 to 2011. Previously he was Full Professor of Business Economics, first at the University of Turin and then at Luiss, and Director, from 1974 to 1995, of the Institute of Research on Enterprise and Development, the main body of the National Research Council in the field of economics.

ANDREA RUCKSTUHL

Andrea is currently Head of Continental Europe of Lendlease, with a particular focus on large-scale urban regeneration schemes. As part of this activity Andrea is leading initiatives to explore innovative ways of delivering sustainable urban regeneration, including how to tackle some of the biggest challenges cities are facing such as the provision of social infrastructure. Andrea has over 20 years of experience in the infrastructure and property industry in international markets. He joined BLL as Senior Project Manager in 2004 with responsibilities over a PPP hospital project, the start-up of over €1,5b urban regeneration project in Milan and a large PPP scheme of over €5b in Montecarlo. In 2007 he was appointed Country Manager and since then worked to reposition the business in the contracting and PPP sector. In 2012 he took the role of Executive General Manager for the CEMEA region overlooking the restructuring of the business in the Region with over 18 countries. In 2014 he joined the Regional Board in EUROPE in London and become a member of the Regional Investment Committee.
