Art. 1 Introduction

Intesa Sanpaolo S.p.A., in the pursuit of its institutional aims, agree to collaborate with **Alta Scuola Politecnica (Politecnico di Torino and Politecnico di Milano)** in order to facilitate the choices of young students and to favor their access to the world of work, with testimonials, internships and also the establishment and allocation of scholarships for the two-year period 2021/2023 related to the 18th cycle of the Alta Scuola Politecnica.

Alta Scuola Politecnica (Politecnico di Torino and Politecnico di Milano), on behalf of Intesa Sanpaolo S.p.A., will award **10 scholarships** among the 150 students admitted to the 18th cycle for academic year 2021/22 at Politecnico di Torino and Politecnico di Milano. **5 scholarships** will be assigned to 18th cycle students of Politecnico di Torino and **5 scholarships** will be assigned to 18th cycle students of Politecnico di Milano. The assignment procedure will be carried out jointly with Politecnico di Torino and Politecnico di Milano.

Art. 2 Amount, number and duration of the scholarships

The gross amount of the **10 scholarships** is **12.000 €** divided into two years (**6.000 € per year**). Each scholarship covers the two years of the Master's Degree for A.Y. 2021/22 and 2022/23. The awarding of the scholarship is subject to the achievement of ASP requirements (art. 8 and art. 9).

Art. 3 Requirements to apply and Incompatibility

Requirements to apply

The **10 scholarships** will be distributed as follows:

- 1. 4 scholarships (2 at Politecnico di Torino and 2 at Politecnico di Milano)** to be awarded to **female** students of **Italian nationality, without preclusion** of Master's Degree enrolment at Politecnico di Torino or Milano;
- 2. 6 scholarships (3 at Politecnico di Torino and 3 at Politecnico di Milano)** to students of any nationality, enrolled preferably in a Master's Degree in **Computer Engineering** at Politecnico di Torino or Milano.

In case of absence of applications for the 4 scholarships reserved to female students of Italian nationality, without preclusion of Master's Degree enrolment at Politecnico di Torino or Milano, they will be awarded to students of any nationality, enrolled preferably in a Master's Degree in Computer Engineering at Politecnico di Torino or Milano as indicated at point 2.

Incompatibility

This scholarship cannot be combined with other sources of financial aid such as the Regional Agency for the Right to Education of Piedmont (EDISU), Diritto Studio Universitario (DSU), the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI), TOPoliTO scholarship, Invest your talent (IYT), Gold and Platinum scholarship, ASP Financial Aid (reserved only to non-Italian citizens with a non-Italian Bachelor's degree enrolled to Politecnico di Torino). **Only ASP 18th cycle students of Politecnico di Torino, who benefit of the ASP Financial Aid, can apply to this Call for applications and in case they are awarded this scholarship they have to renounce to the ASP Financial Aid.**

Art. 4

How to apply and deadline

Applications are due on **15th March 2022 at 12.00 (noon - Italian time - CET)** through the **Ticketing assistance service** of Politecnico di Torino (ASP - Alta Scuola Politecnica): <https://didattica.polito.it/segreteria/contatta/en/asp.html>.

Applicants have to communicate their interest to apply for this scholarship.

Art. 5

Assignment requirements and procedure

Applicants selection will be based on the selection final score (maximum of 100 points) assigned to candidates in order to be admitted to the ASP 18th cycle.

At the end of this process the Evaluation Committee will draw up **the ranking list of the first 30 applicants to be admitted** (art. 3 point 2: priority in the ranking for applicants enrolled in Computer Engineering) to the second step of the selection process, which consists in a video interview held in English and carried out by the Evaluation Committee.

The list of applicants admitted to the interview and all the necessary information about the interview will be published on the ASP website (www.asp-poli.it). Applicants are required to attend the online interview through Microsoft Teams on the established date and time. Failure to attend the interview entails the exclusion of the applicant from the selection process.

Applicants can be assigned a maximum of 100 points for their performance in the interview.

After the interview, **two separate lists of standings (one for scholarships in art. 3 point 1 and one for scholarships in art. 3 point 2) for each Politecnico**, with students matching all requirements indicated in art. 3, will be drawn up based on the sum of the final score and the interview scores (maximum of 200 points). Scores will be ordered from the highest score, in descending order. Assignments will be based on the number of scholarships available on this call.

Art. 6

Publication of list of standings

Lists of standings with assigned and eligible applicants will be published in the ASP website (www.asp-poli.it). The lists of standings will be published in the online Official Register of the Politecnico di Torino.

This is, for all intents and purposes, the only official notification of scholarship awarding.

Alta Scuola Politecnica assumes no responsibility for the applicant's failure to view the standings and/or to accept the scholarship according to the terms published in the online Official Register of Politecnico di Torino.

Art. 7

Scholarship acceptance

Assigned students will have to officially accept the scholarship according to the procedures and within the deadlines published in the ASP website (www.asp-poli.it), under penalty of loss of the scholarship itself.

By accepting the scholarship, assigned students will state their full acceptance of the conditions laid down in the call for applications, and declare, under their own full responsibility, that they do not fall within any of the conditions of incompatibility laid down in art. 3 of this call for applications. They shall also commit to notify the university of any variation in the declared information which may arise during the year.

Art. 8

Payment of the scholarship

The scholarship is **finally assigned and paid by the Politecnico** each applicant is enrolled to and physically based in Italy within November 2022, in two instalments as follows:

- In November 2022
- In June 2023

In particular, payment of the **first instalment** is subordinate to the possession of the ASP requirements **within November 2022**. If the assigned applicant does not maintain the ASP requirements or withdraw from the Alta Scuola Politecnica, for any reason, he/she will lose the right to the scholarship.

Art. 9

Requirements to maintain the scholarship

Scholarship recipients will have to maintain the ASP requirements **within June 2023** for the payment of the **second instalment**. If the assigned applicant does not maintain the ASP requirements or withdraw from the Alta Scuola Politecnica, for any reason, he/she will lose the right to the scholarship.

Art. 10

Official in charge of the administrative procedure

According to art. 5 of Italian Law n. 241 of 07/08/1990, the official in charge of the administrative procedure concerning this call for applications is Mrs. Paola Melchionda (Head of the Course Catalogue and Teaching Quality Assurance Service of Politecnico di Torino).
